The following are courses that we suggest you complete in order to work on the road or roadside.

Traffic Control Person: This course provides instruction to become a highway signaler in the Province of NB. This course is accepted by the DTI and WorkSafeNB as it meets their Traffic Control Person requirements. (In-person or eLearning)

DTI WATCM 2019 Rev: This course is designed to help students understand and implement the N.B. Department of Transportation and Infrastructure WATCM Manual. It has been accepted by the DTI and WorkSafeNB as meeting their requirements.

Trenching Awareness: This course is an introduction to the hazards of trenching and excavation. This informative course will help workers identify trenching hazards and recognize the protection required. This course is ideal for any employee working around or in an excavation/trench. (In-person or eLearning)
