With the assistance of a grant from PETL, NBCSA was able to develop interactive training courses for WHMIS, Safety Orientation and Fall Protection.


These courses offer an alternate way for employers to ensure that they are meeting training requirements under the NBOHS Act for all employees regardless of language or educational barriers.
