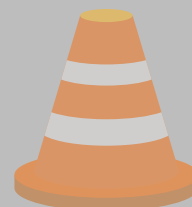
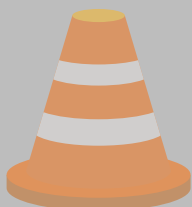


The day's final presentation was by David Powers on the topic of discipline and when it is appropriate. This interactive presentation was a perfect fit to close the day.
