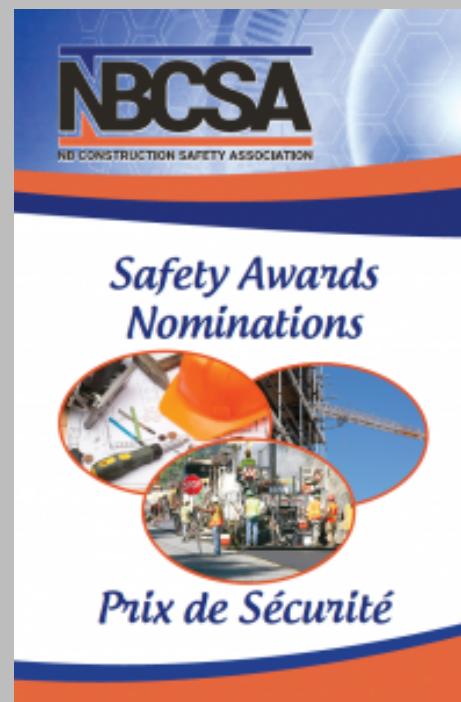
LEADERSHIP AWARD: This award will be given to a company that has exceeded minimum standards in the area of training and development and implementation of program policies and procedures.
