



Winter Safety

As winter settles in, we would like to emphasize the importance of road safety in challenging weather conditions. Snow, ice, and cold temperatures pose unique challenges for drivers, making it crucial to adopt safe practices on the road.

Reduced visibility and slippery roads mean cautious driving. Allow for extra time to reach your destination, and maintain a safe following distance to account for sudden stops.

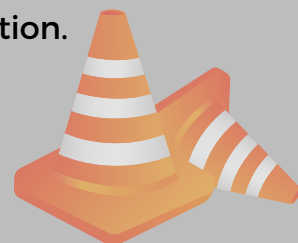
Have an emergency kit in your vehicle. It should include:

- Sand or kitty litter for traction on icy roads.
- Jumper cables and a portable battery charger.
- First aid kit.
- Extra windshield washer fluid.
- Emergency contact information.

General Regulation 91-191 - Legislative amendments and regulatory review

General Regulation 91-191 is undergoing numerous legislative changes that will enhance health and safety in New Brunswick workplaces. Amendments were broken into three phases due to the broad range of topics.

The final phase is expected to be complete early in 2024 and will include these topics:

- Explosives
- Hearing loss prevention
- Laser radiation
- Portable compressed gas containers
- Lighting
- Emergency eyewash and shower requirements
- Ladders
- Personal protective equipment
- X-ray safety
- Demolition
- Scaffolding

Worksafe is also reviewing Regulation 96-105 Underground Mine

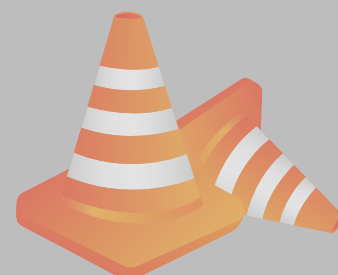
