

Certificate of Recognition (COR®) Program Application for Reciprocity

Certificate of Recognition (COR®) Program is a nationally recognized safety and health certification program for employers in the construction and related industries.

COR® is an occupational safety and health accreditation program that verifies a fully implemented safety and health management system which meets national standards. The objectives of COR® are to provide industry employers with effective tools to develop, implement, assess, and promote continual improvement of their safety and health management system to prevent or mitigate incidents and injuries as well as their associated human and financial costs.

COR® is now frequently used as a pre-qualifying and/or condition of contract by public and private project owners across Canada.

Companies possessing a valid Certificate of Recognition and/or valid Letter of Good Standing from their Provincial/Territorial Construction Safety Association (CFCSA Member) <u>AND do not have a base of operation in New Brunswick</u>, are eligible to apply for a Letter of Good Standing-Reciprocity with NBCSA. Companies operating in the province of Quebec, proof of successful participation of a CFCSA COR® audit will be accepted.

Businesses seeking NBCSA Reciprocity must:

- -Request an application for COR® Reciprocity from and completed by your host Construction Safety Association.
- -Be a Member or Associate Member of your host Provincial/Territorial Construction Safety Association (will be verified with accompanying CFCSA Application for COR® Reciprocity)
- -Complete the attached declaration on page 2.
- -Provide a Certificate of Recognition and/or a valid Letter of Good Standing from your host Provincial/Territorial Construction Safety Association
- -Provide a valid Clearance Certificate from your host Provincial Worker's Compensation Board. If available, also provide a Clearance Certificate from WorkSafeNB.
- -If or when being awarded a contract in the Province of New Brunswick, a Provincial Quality Assurance Audit will be conducted at applicable rates.
